

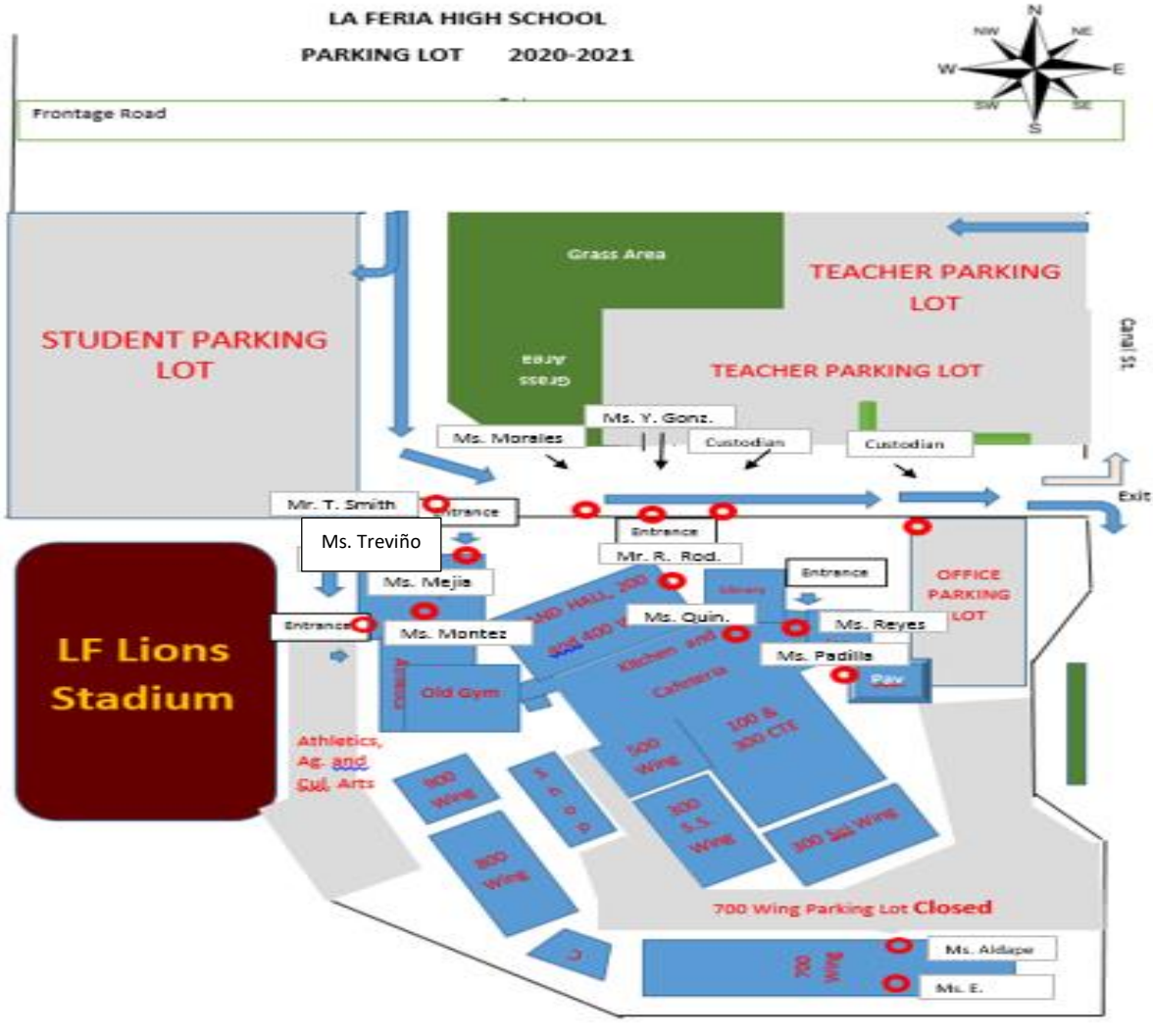
**LA FERIA HIGH SCHOOL DAILY SAFETY PROCEDURES**

**Morning Procedures** –

Students' temperatures will be checked before they get on the school bus, as students are being dropped off by their parents or as they drive onto campus or walk on to campus. The students will walk straight to the New Gym. Students will be held in the New Gym from 7:00 am to 7:45 am with social distancing designated throughout the gym.

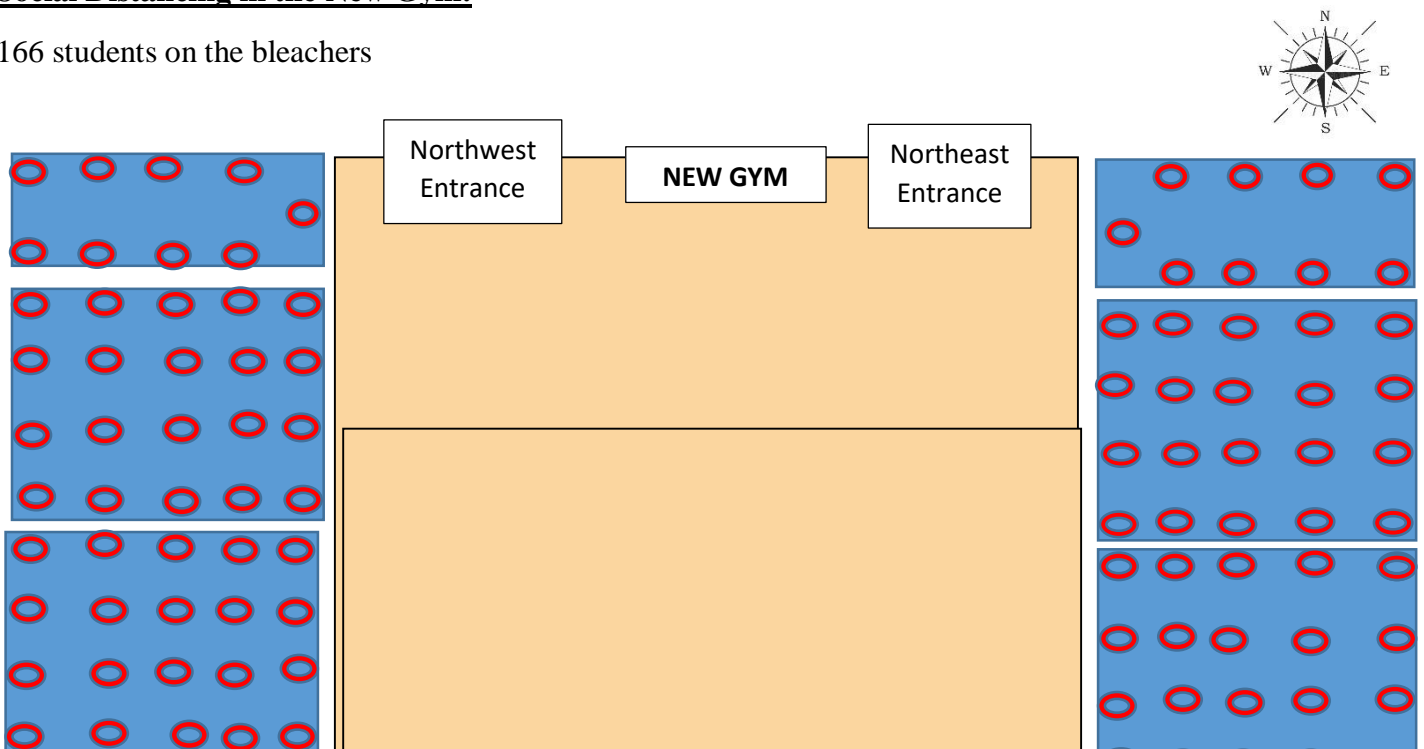
**For students that are dropped off,...**

- Ms. Morales and Ms. Y. Gonzalez will meet students at the drop off area to monitor social distancing. Drop off area is located at the front of the Main Office.
- A Custodian will be doing the Cross Guard Duty.
- Students will be dropped off at designated areas designed to allow for social distancing.
- Ms. Morales and Ms. Y. Gonzalez will be available at the identified drop-off/pick-up location to verify that the parent has completed the self-check form while the student is in the vehicle.
- Student temperature will be checked prior to exiting the car.
- Students will enter the campus through the Main Office entrance and go to the New Gym or their classroom depending on when they are being dropped off.

**For students that walk/Drive to school,...**

- Each student will be assigned a designated entrance/exit to reduce traffic and interaction between students
  - Students driving will park in the Northwest parking lot of the campus only (in front of the stadium) and **will enter the campus through the New Gym.**
  - Students that walk into campus will enter the campus through the campus main gate entrance only and an office staff will be there to check their temperature.
- Mr. T. Smith and Ms. R. Treviño will be available at the New Gym Main Entrance to complete the screening with the student and take the student's temperature.
- After being checked students will go to the New Gym until 7:30 am when they will be released a section at a time to their classrooms.
- Students will maintain Social Distancing while waiting in the New Gym.



- Students will sit in the designated locations on the bleachers to maintain Social Distancing.
- If we have an overflow of students before 7:45 am, new arrivals will be sent to the old gym.
- Students will be released at 7:45 am by sections starting with the closest to the South entrance of the gym.
- Students will walk to their classrooms following the signage on the floor to maintain their social distancing.

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- Hallways are marked so that students walk on their right side of the hallway keeping six feet apart as they walk to class.



### **For students that ride the bus,...**

- Students that ride the bus will enter the campus through the Pavilion entrance.
- Ms. Padilla will monitor students as they walk from the Pavilion to the cafeteria.
- Bus riders will be held at the cafeteria with social distancing from 7:00 am to 7:45 am.
- Students will be released at 7:45 am by sections from the cafeteria.
- Students will walk to their classrooms following the signage on the floor to maintain their social distancing.
- Hallways are marked so that students walk on their right side of the hallway keeping six feet apart as they walk to class.

### **Breakfast –**

Students will be released to their first period classrooms at 7:45 am and will pick up a Grab &Go breakfast from designated locations as they exit the New Gym and/or the Cafeteria. Students will eat in the classroom from 7:45 am to 8:00 am.

- As students exit the New Gym or the Cafeteria they will pick up the Grab & Go breakfast from designated areas.
- We will have Kiosks serving stations at the west entrance of the Old Gym, right outside the Old Gym, at the hallway near the Nook and at the Salad Bar Station.
- Students will eat breakfast in class and dispose of trash when completed.
- Breakfast will end at 8:00 am.
- First period class will start at 8:00 am.

### **Student-Teacher Groupings (Classrooms)-**

Where feasible without disrupting the educational experience, La Feria High School will encourage students to

practice social distancing.

- In classroom spaces that allow it, La Feria High School will place student desks a minimum of six feet apart when possible. There will be a maximum of 20 desks per classroom.
- In classrooms where students are regularly within six feet of one another, La Feria High School will plan for more frequent hand washing and/or hand sanitizing and will consider whether increased airflow from the outdoors is possible.
- To reduce congestion and help with Social Distancing students will be divided by grade level into different buildings for their core and Spanish classes. Freshmen will be in the 700 Wing, sophomores will be in the 300 Science and Social Studies Wing, juniors will be in the 800 Wing and seniors will be in the 100 Wing. CTE and Fine Arts will mainly remain in their current classes.
- Students will wear their masks at all times while on campus and in the classrooms.
- When entering a classroom students will use hand sanitizer and keep their hands to themselves.
- When possible students will seat in every other desk to keep a distance between each other.
- At the beginning of class, students will provided a wipe cloth so that they may sanitize their desks.
- If students leave the classroom they will use the sanitizer when they walk back into the room.
- Students will not share supplies in the classroom.
- Students will be held in the old gym during their P.E. class.
- If classroom capacity exceeds the recommended social distancing limits, that classroom will be relocated to either the cafeteria or library when possible.
- When library or cafeteria are not available, classes will be split and students will be relocated into other classrooms that have adequate space for social distancing.

### **Passing Periods (Hallway Traffic)**

- In an effort to reduce congestion in hallways, the campus has established one-way directional pathways.
- Signage on floors and around the campus will assist in maintaining social distance.
- Students that are going from one building to another will be released one minute before the bell rings.
- Students that are moving from one class to another in the same building will be dismissed at regular bell schedule.
- Students will maintain social distancing as much as possible.
- Teachers and staff will monitor hallways to ensure students are maintaining their social distancing.
- Teachers will disinfect their classroom every other period so that we always have teachers monitoring the hallways.
- Restrooms will be closed during passing periods to mitigate students congregating.
- Students will be allowed to go to the restrooms one by one ten minutes after the start of class.

### **Lunches**

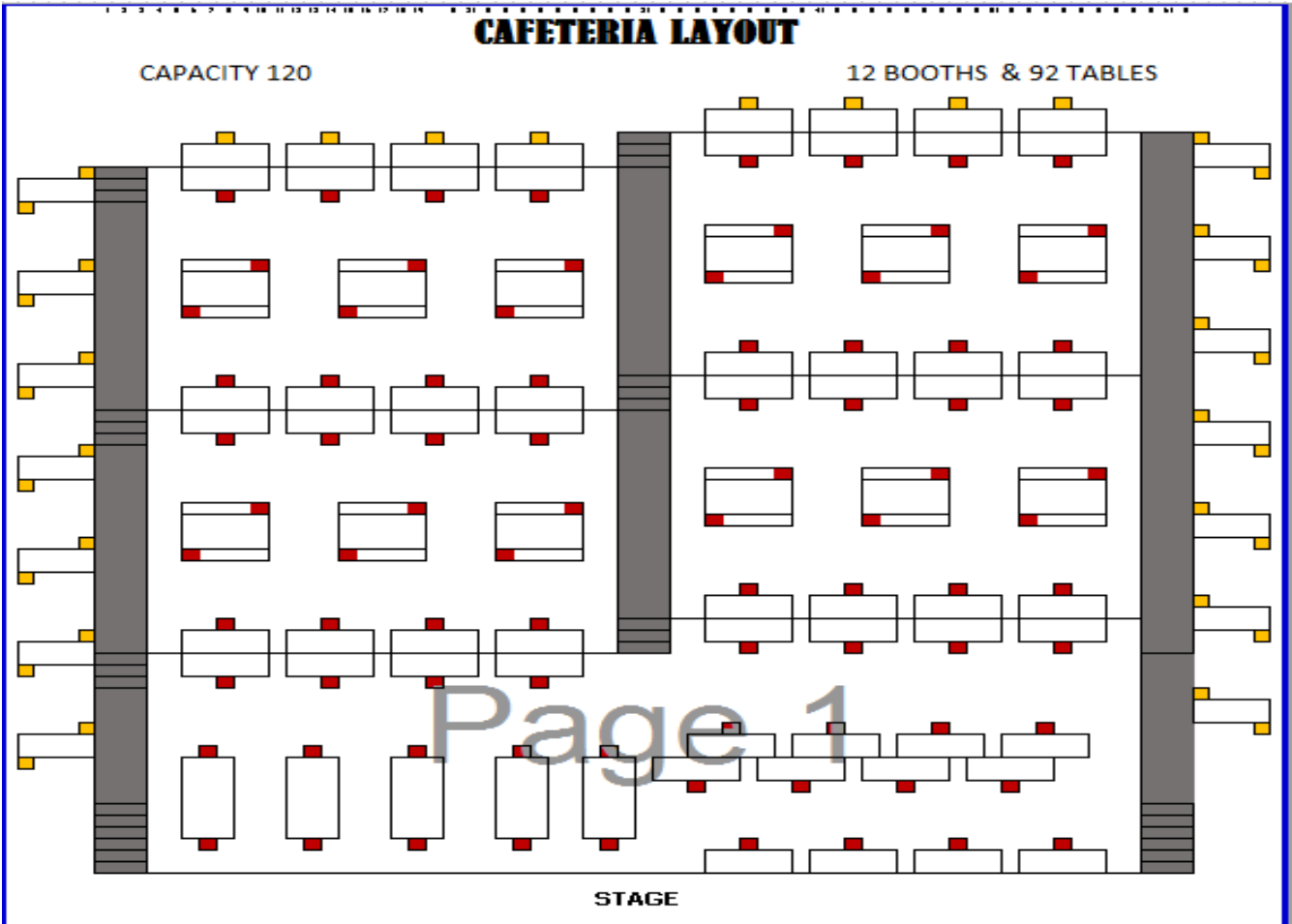
This school year we will have three lunches instead of two, 4<sup>th</sup> Period A Lunch will start at the end of 3<sup>rd</sup> period at 10:43 am (4<sup>th</sup> period), 5<sup>th</sup> Period B Lunch will start at the end of 4<sup>th</sup> period at 11:37 am (5<sup>th</sup> period), and 6<sup>th</sup> Period C Lunch will start at the end of 5<sup>th</sup> period at 12:31 pm (6<sup>th</sup> period). There will be 19 minutes between lunches so that areas may be sanitized. Lunches will be 35 minutes long and the last lunch will end at 1:06 pm same as previous years.

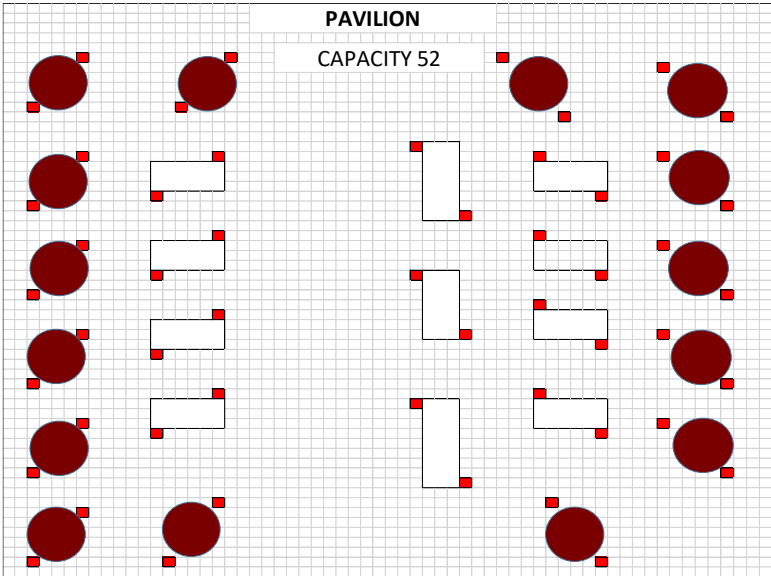
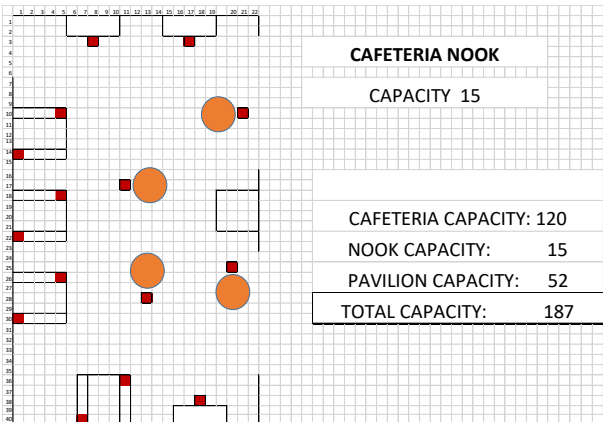
We have two options for the lunches:

#### **Option 1**

Students will eat at the cafeteria area, the cafeteria nook and/or the pavilion while maintaining social distancing. If it rains, students from the pavilion will be located in the Old Gym.

- Students will have four different serving line area to pick up their lunch plates.
- Two lines will be at the front of the cafeteria, one will be at the salad bar area and the last one will be at the pavilion, or the Old Gym if it necessitates.
- Students will be released from the classrooms and they will find a seat in the designated areas.
- Students will be released by sections to pick up their lunch, this will mitigate the possibility of students congregating.
- At the end of their lunch period students will be released by sections to allow for social distancing.





**Option 2**

Students will eat lunch in available classrooms.

- **4 A Lunch will be in 300 Sci. and Soc. Stud. Wings**
- **5 B Lunch will be in the 800 Wing and**
- **6 C Lunch will be in the 100 Wing.**
- Students will be assigned to classrooms based on alphabetical order.
- Students will be aware of their assigned classroom for lunch.
- Para-professionals, Office Staff, Counselors and Administration will cover the classrooms while teachers go to lunch.
- Cafeteria staff will deliver lunches to the classrooms with Kiosk stations.

## Dismissals

If students are Bus Riders they will go to the pavilion immediately at 3:48 pm. If Students are walkers they will be released 3 minutes later at 3:51 pm and immediately leave campus. Finally, Pick-ups or drive will be dismissed at 3:54 pm and sent to the cafeteria to wait for the buses.

- Extra-Curricular students will be released one minute before the bell rings to go to their designated areas.
  - Football players report to the Old Gym
  - Volleyball players report to New Gym
  - Band students will report to Band Hall
- Bus Riders will be released at 3:48 pm and will go straight to the pavilion to wait for their bus.
- Walkers will be released at 3:51 and will exit the campus immediately.
- Students that will be picked up will be dismissed at 3:54 pm and will exit through the main entrance.
  - These students will wait outside maintaining social distancing.
- Students that are drivers will be dismissed at 3:54 pm and will exit the campus through the entrance next through the band hall or the 400 Wing Exit doors.
  - These students will exit the campus through the frontage road exit.

## **While at school, students will be required to follow these guidelines:**

- Students shall wear masks at all times
- Students shall maintain social distancing of at least 6 feet from one another **when feasible**.
- Students shall wash their hands and/or use hand sanitizer throughout their time in the building.
- Students will be required to wear their Student ID cards.
- Students shall not shake hands, touch, or hug others.

## Sanitization Procedures

- Classrooms will be sanitized twice daily. Classroom desks will be sanitized between class periods. Staff will prop open doors in classrooms and halls to eliminate the possibility of the spreading of the virus on doors.
- Restrooms will be sanitized three times per day. La Feria High School will install touchless faucets for sinks, touchless hand soap dispensers, touchless paper towel dispensers, dividers between sinks, and automatic toilets and urinals.

## Campus Isolation Procedures related to CoVid-19

- If a student or staff member displays symptoms of CoVid-19, the school nurse will provide a clinical assessment to determine if and when a student/staff needs to be sent home.
- Students or staff who come in close proximity to a case of CoVid-19 will be asked to self-quarantine for 14 days. And should contact the school for meeting the RETURN TO SCHOOL CRITERIA.
- District communication will be provided to the staff and students who come in contact with anyone who tests positive for CoVid-19. \* See Notification Chart
- LFISD will immediately sanitize all areas that had exposure from someone who tested positive. In the event that this cannot be done before the start of the next school day, LFISD may need to close some



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classrooms, campuses, or the entire district for a day to complete the process of relocating students and staff.

- Any student requiring quarantine will transition to remote learning for the duration of the isolation period.

**Staff needing to self-isolate will:**

- If possible will continue serving all their students through Google Classroom and Zoom Sessions.
- Substitute will be hired to monitor student behavior in the classroom.

Once a student chooses virtual (remote) learning, **they must remain remote for the 6 weeks grading period** before they are able to make a change in their learning environment. **In the case of a student who is failing at progress report, the student will be asked to come back for face to face instruction.**

Accommodations and support services will be provided to all remote learners.
